Have a wildly wonderful Solstice! ☀️

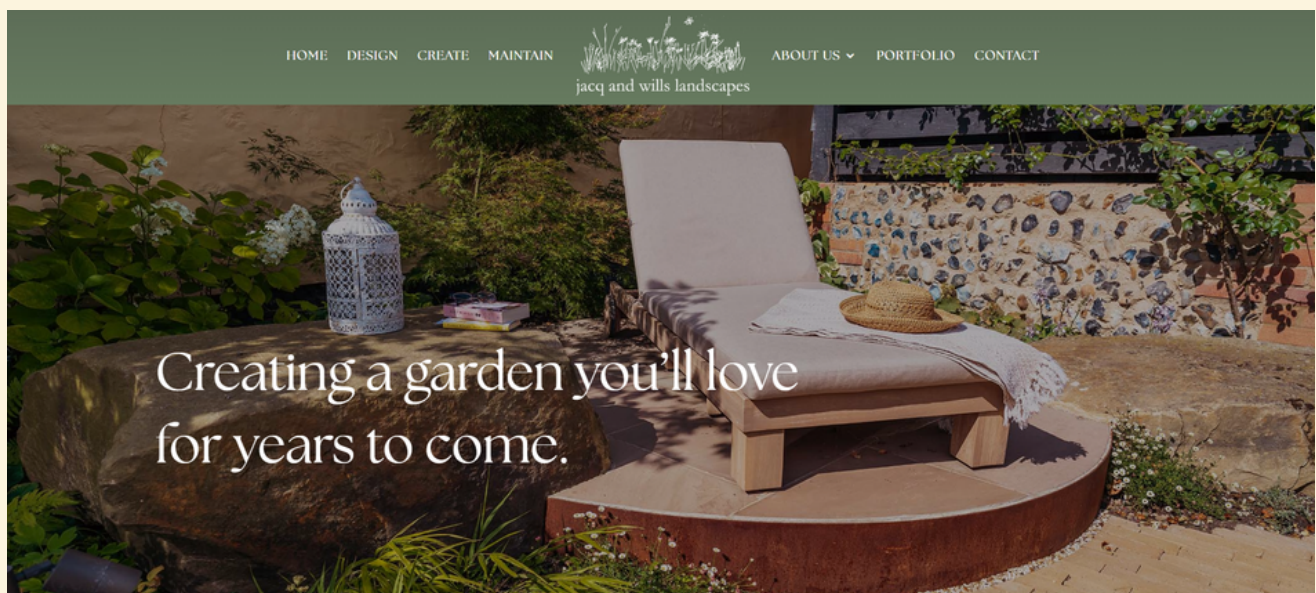
What we've been up to in June...

Our clients wanted a space they could host in, unwind and admire just as much from their conservatory window as from within the garden itself. What's emerged is a warm, welcoming space that naturally draws people outside.

The layout is built around gentle movement and soft transitions. Cobbled setts guide you through the garden with a lovely rustic texture, leading you from the house into the heart of the space. A handcrafted softwood pergola adds height and structure, creating a natural gathering point for long summer evenings.



Two reflective water bowls sit nestled within the planting, catching the light and drawing wildlife in close. They're simple features, but they bring so much atmosphere, interest and calm to the space.



The planting is soft, drought-tolerant and has a contemporary cottage-garden feel. It brings colour, texture and movement, allowing the garden to shift beautifully with the elements.



Through the addition of carefully placed lighting the garden gets to shine no matter the time of day or season. It becomes a space to enjoy long evenings and year-round atmosphere.

From the early renders to the final touches on site, watching this garden come together has been a joy.

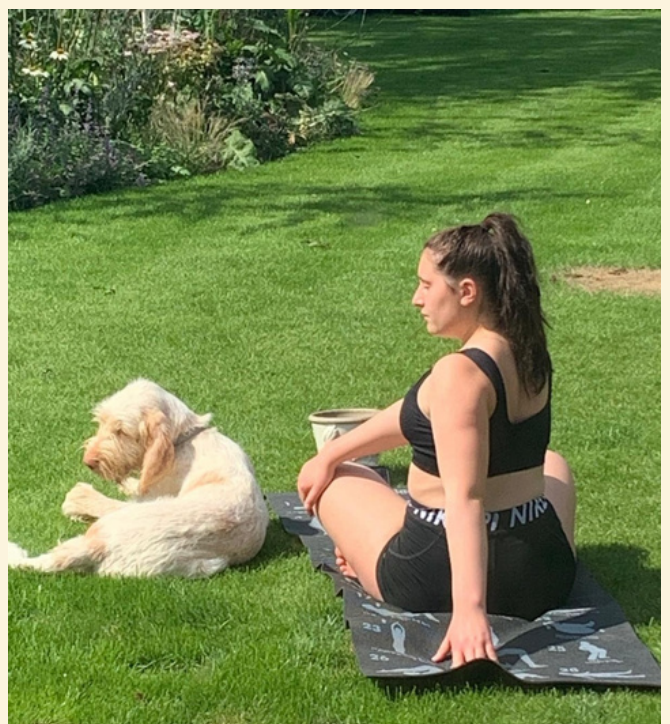
Midyear Mindset
