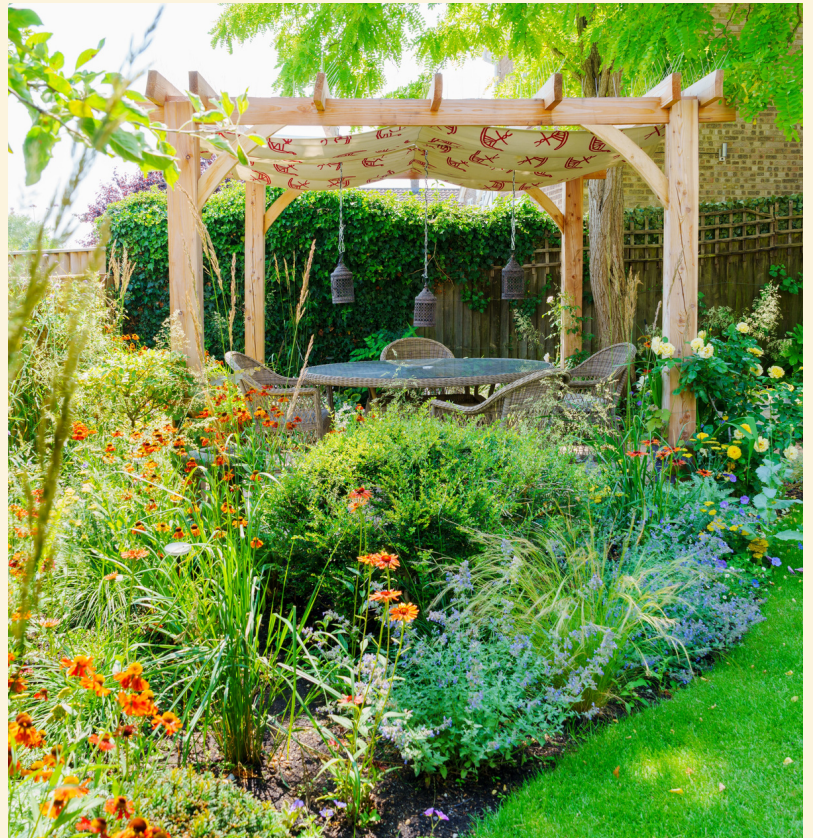

A Shady Town Garden

We first designed a garden for these clients several years ago, creating a sunny, Mediterranean-inspired space that suited their home perfectly at the time. But after a new extension reshaped the layout and cast much of the garden into shade, the space needed a fresh approach and it was a joy to go through the design process with them all over again.



What had once been a bright, open garden had become a cooler, more sheltered environment, giving us the opportunity to experiment with a completely different palette. We embraced the change, creating a lush tapestry of shade-tolerant planting in rich greens, punctuated with gentle pops of colour. The planting now wraps around the garden, bringing softness, depth and a sense of calm immersion in nature.

A series of circular steel steps lead you on a gentle journey through the planting, guiding you down onto the main patio. This subtle shift in levels adds movement and curiosity, encouraging you to wander and explore the space rather than simply pass through it.



Around the patio, we built a handcrafted dry-stone wall seat, a tactile, timeless feature that anchors the garden and offers a quiet place to pause. Behind it, a water feature creates a mindful focal point, its reflections and soft sounds adding atmosphere and serenity.



Together, these elements form a garden that feels intimate, characterful and deeply connected to nature. It's a space shaped by the changing architecture of the home, the evolving needs of the clients and the joy of designing with shade rather than fighting it.

We're incredibly proud of how this garden has grown since 2022, watching the planting mature, the textures deepen and the sanctuary truly come to life. 🌿
